The Constitution of the Republic of INTERNET Designed for the Digital Age

Preamble

We, the digital citizens of the Republic of INTERNET, in order to establish a free, inclusive, innovative, and secure digital society, hereby enact this Constitution to safeguard our rights, responsibilities, and values in the boundless realm of cyberspace.

Article I – General Provisions

Nature of the Republic
 The Republic of INTERNET is a sovereign

digital micronation, existing independently of geographical boundaries and governed by its citizens through digital platforms.

2. Values and Objectives
The Republic is founded on the principles
of freedom, equality, technological
advancement, digital safety, and the free
exchange of information.

Article II - Citizenship

1. Eligibility

Any individual from any country may apply to become a digital citizen, regardless of

race, nationality, gender, or religion.

2. Rights of Citizens
Citizens shall have the right to:

Access all public digital services offered by the Republic.

Participate in referendums and community decision-making.

Express opinions freely in accordance with respectful communication standards.

Privacy and protection of their personal data.

3. Duties of Citizens

Citizens shall:

Respect the Constitution and the values of the Republic.

Engage constructively in the community.

Refrain from digital misconduct, including hate speech, fraud, or harassment.

Article III - Government and Administration

1. Structure

The Republic shall be governed by a digital administrative council, led by the Founder

and supported by moderators and developers.

2. Founder and Executive Authority

The Founder is the symbolic head and highest executive authority.

The Founder may appoint officers and delegates to oversee operations.

3. Digital Council

The Digital Council shall propose and vote on new policies and updates to this Constitution.

All changes shall be made public and

recorded transparently.

Article IV - Digital Rights and Freedoms

1. Freedom of Speech Every citizen shall have the right to express themselves online, within the limits of community guidelines.

2. Right to Privacy
No citizen's personal data shall be collected or shared without explicit consent.

3. Access to Technology
Citizens are encouraged to contribute to
and benefit from open-source digital tools
and services.

4. Freedom of Information
The Republic supports the free flow of nonmalicious, verified, and educational
information.

Article V - Security and Conduct

Cyber Ethics
 Citizens must act ethically and avoid illegal

or harmful activity online.

2. Data Protection
The Republic will take measures to ensure the protection of data stored within its systems.

3. Bans and Suspensions
Any citizen violating constitutional
principles may be temporarily or
permanently suspended following a fair
review.

1. E-Passport and E-ID

Approved citizens will be issued an electronic passport and identity document, accessible only with secure login.

2. Verification

All applications are reviewed by the administrative body before approval.

Article VII - Language and Communication

1. Official Language

English shall be the official language of the Republic, with multilingual support for

inclusivity.

2. Transparency All official updates, decisions, and changes will be publicly posted in the main portal.

Article VIII - Amendments

 Proposal Process
 Any citizen may propose a constitutional amendment via a dedicated platform.

2. Approval

Amendments must be reviewed and approved by the Digital Council and validated by a public vote if necessary.

Ratified on the 1st of April, 2025
This document represents the foundational values and operational structure of the Republic of INTERNET.
